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The present drawing was executed during Pablo Gargallo's formative years in Paris. He must have drawn it when visiting a circus (perhaps Medrano Circus). It could alternatively depict a theatre.

Like many other great artists, Gargallo used drawing as a support for his sculpture production. Although he is better remembered for his sculptures, drawings were an essential part of his *oeuvre*.
