Arab Warriors on Horseback, was created by Georges Washington (1827-1901), an artist renowned for depicting Arabian horses and scenes from Algeria and Morocco. The painting shows mounted Arab warriors navigating rugged terrain, with a central figure atop a white and grey dappled stallion gesturing forward. It highlights Washington's skill as an equestrian painter and his consummate understanding of Arab customs and attire; knowledge gained during his travels in the Near East. Influenced by artists such as Eugène Delacroix (1798-1863) and Eugène Fromentin (1820-1876), Washington's style is marked by a vivid palette, dramatic compositions, and expressive brushwork, emphasising the exoticism and vitality of his subjects.
