



Ricard Canals was an artist who influenced an entire generation.

He travelled to Paris with Isidre Nonell in 1896 and established a close relationship with Picasso there, upon whom his work made a strong impression.

Durand-Ruel was Canals' dealer in Paris, and he was able to organize important exhibitions for him all over Europe.

The present drawing was executed during one of the artist's regular visits to the French capital. It was sent to Barcelona to be published in the satirical and cultural magazine *Almanach de L'Esquella de la Torratxa* in 1899.
