A Greek terracotta jug covered in a rich, thick black glaze, with a neck sharply fluting into a hard-edged shoulder, complemented by a tapering body which also serves as the unfooted base. The elegant, S-shaped handle is attached at the base of the neck and the rear of the spout, which is upward-reaching and open-topped.
